- Select vineyard blocks that reflect the distinctive, natural characters in *lower* Wairau Valley producing a wine with distinct pungency and power
- Named after the native New Zealand sheepdog, Huntaway has distinguished herding and working abilities like no other breed

WHAT MAKES HUNTAWAY SAUVIGNON BLANC SPECIAL?

- Sourced from the “lower” Wairau Valley, in the heart of Marlborough
- Hallmarks of the “lower Wairau” style – big, aromatic, full pallet weight, clean acid
- Rich clay soils require no irrigation (dry farmed)
