Extreme elevation exposes our grapes to an intense amount of sunlight and UV rays, giving our small clusters of grapes an amazingly dark, concentrated "inky" color

Medium bodied wines with hints of cool climate characteristics, subtle integration of oak (6 months only on French oak) and juice ripe fruit concentration on palate
