aromas

- Bright lemon citrus & curd and honeysuckle floral notes
- A hint of spice and pie crust
- Delicate richness on the nose

flavors

- Juicy fresh pineapple, nectarine and crisp Fuji apple
- A touch of baking spice adds weight to the palate
- Crisp and creamy finish

dough pairings

- Picture a glass of dough Chardonnay alongside the perfect cheese board: local artisan goat cheeses, a wedge of Manchego, fresh-baked crostini, Marcona almonds and a pot of fig jam.

technical information

This wine is mostly barrel fermented, French oak aged with a smaller percentage of stainless steel fermented parcels which capture bright fruit and acid.
